Why did you choose this program over others?



I thought that it was good fit because going during May session allowed me to take the time to go abroad but not be behind in any of my schoolwork. It was also financially a better fit.

I think it's incredibly important for CBS students to not only understand the importance of science and logic but also understand the social implications of the concepts we are learning about




